2026 ICE SHOW REQUIREMENTS

All soloists must register September through June for a minimum of three 50-minute freestyle sessions on two days per week. Trio/duo skaters must register for a minimum of two 50- minute freestyle sessions on two days per week to remain eligible for their feature in future ice shows. The Learn-to-Skate program and the Wednesday 6 pm halfhour freestyle session does not count toward this ice show requirement.
